



## 2011 G-Inno Scholarship

1. Overview

The G-Inno Best Paper Award is made possible by the generous support of the Global Innovation Systems (G-INNO SYSTEMS), a Seoul-based GIS firm. For a paper to qualify for the G-Inno Best Paper Award, a student must be the lead author of the paper presented in an academic conference.

- 2. Eligibility
  - a. KAGES membership
  - b. Scholarship is open to South Koreans and Korean-Americans.
  - c. Applicants must be full-time graduate or undergraduate students in colleges/universities in North America.
  - d. Fields of Study: GIS/Remote Sensing/Human and Physical Geography/Environmental Science
  - e. Former award recipients may re-apply after an interval of three years.
- 3. Scholarship Award
  - a. Number of awardee: Two
  - b. Amount: \$400 (USD)
- 3. Application material
  - a. Application form
  - b. 1-page curriculum vitae
  - c. Transcript from currently-attending school (a scanned image or a PDF file directly printed off from the Web)
  - d. A 3-pages extended abstract of the research that will be presented at AAG, ASPRS, ESRI User Conference, or other national/international conferences
  - e. Proof of conference presentation (a page in the preliminary program or a web screen captured image showing presentation schedule can be accepted)
- 4. Submission: All materials should be submitted via email (support@kages.org).

5. Application deadline: March 31, 2011

KAGES will inform scholarship recipients by April 11, 2011. Award ceremony will be held during the KAGES Annual Meeting in 2011. Further information is available at KAGES website (<u>www.kages.org</u>).
