



2011 Pixoneer Scholarship

1. Overview

The Pixoneer Scholarship was established in 2008 by Pixoneer Geomatics, Inc. to provide financial assistance to graduate students in the research field of Geography, Geospatial Technologies and Environmental Sciences. Pixoneer Geomatics, Inc. is a GIS and remote sensing firm located at Daejon, South Korea, and the scholarship is awarded annually to five students through the generous sponsorship of its CEO Jong Sik Yoon.

2. Eligibility

- a. KAGES membership
- b. Scholarship is open to South Koreans and Korean-Americans.
- c. Fields of Study: GIS/Remote Sensing/Human and Physical Geography/Environmental Science
- d. Applicants must be full-time graduate or undergraduate students in colleges/universities in North America.
- d. Former award recipients may re-apply after an interval of three years.

3. Scholarship Award

- a. Number of awardees: Three
- b. Amount
 - One 1st place: \$400 (USD)
 Two 2nd places: \$300 (USD)

3. Application material

- a. Application form
- b. 1-page curriculum vitae
- c. Transcript from currently-attending school (a scanned image or a PDF file directly printed off from the Web)
- d. A 3-pages extended abstract of the research that will be presented at AAG, ASPRS, ESRI User Conference, or other national/international conferences
- e. Proof of conference presentation (a page in the preliminary program or a web screen captured image showing presentation schedule can be accepted)
- 4. Submission: All materials should be submitted via email (support@kages.org).
- 5. Application deadline: March 31, 2011
